Philosophy

This camp is designed for student-athletes who want to learn more about their respective sports.

Instruction

Campers will receive individual instruction and assistance in all areas of the camp they select. There will be an emphasis on technique, fundamentals, and FUN.

Age Groupings

Campers must be entering 3rd grade. There are no exceptions to this rule. Campers will be grouped according to ability, size, and age.

Daily Activities

Each day will include instruction, skill building, lectures, and competition.

Facilities

Each camp will take place on the Whitehall-Coplay School District campus. Each camp will have its own meeting place.

Insurance

Campers must be adequately insured with personal insurance. In the event of injury or illness requiring treatment, hospitalization, and / or surgery, family medical insurance must be used. An athletic trainer will be on staff at all times.

What to bring?

Campers should bring a lunch for full day camps. Snacks and beverages will be available at camps, though campers may bring their own. No glass containers are allowed. Please mark all items. Camp is not responsible for lost or damaged articles.

What to wear?

Campers should wear sneakers (bring cleats for football camp), socks, shorts, and a t-shirt. Each camper will receive a camp t-shirt.

Staff

Each camp will have a staff that includes coaches and former Whitehall athletes. Camps will include guest speakers and clinicians for various levels of sports.

Camp Confirmation

Your confirmation will be sent via e-mail and will include a health form and insurance information that must be received prior to your athlete participating in camp.
