

## **2022 AP EXAM DAY OF INSTRUCTIONS**

### **ARRIVAL--BE ON TIME! THE EXAM WILL START WITHOUT YOU:**

- For 8:00am exams, students should arrive in their assigned room by 7:45am
- For 12:00pm exams, students should arrive in their assigned room by 11:45am

### **LUNCH/DISMISSAL:**

- Students will be dismissed as an entire room at the completion of the exam time. *Students are not permitted to leave early or when they are finished before the exam time expires.*
- For AM exams
  - Students who have Lunch 1 should go to the NEXT SCHEDULED LUNCH when their exam concludes
  - Students who have Lunches 2 & 3 should go to their scheduled lunch
- For PM exams, students should go to LUNCH 1 at 11:05 and then report to their testing room
- For PM exams; You may not be finished by 2:45 to catch your bus – please arrange for alternate transportation or sign up to take the activity bus home that day

### **REMINDERS:**

- Visit the restroom prior to the test; students may use the restroom during the test (one at a time), but will not receive any extra time.
- Dress in layers; testing rooms may get cold.
- EAT a good meal prior to the test; get plenty of SLEEP the night before.
- Students missing any class time will be responsible for making up any missed assignments.
- If a student brings one of the prohibited devices to the testing (listed below), it will be confiscated. If the device is used during testing or the break, it will be confiscated and the student dismissed from testing and their scores invalidated.

### **What Students SHOULD Bring to the Exam Room:**

- Two sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Two pens, with black or dark blue ink only.
- A watch (not a smart watch) (in case the exam room doesn't have a clock that can be easily seen).
- Up to 2 calculators with the necessary capabilities if they are taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, or Statistics Exam. See the [AP Calculator Policy](#) for approved versions.
- A ruler or straightedge if they're taking an AP Physics Exam.

### **What Students SHOULD NOT Bring to the Exam Room:**

- Electronics (phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, devices that can access the internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices).
- Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, or colored pencils.
- Rulers, straightedges (these are allowed only for AP Physics Exams).
- Protractors, ear plugs, clipboards, watches that beep or have an alarm.
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets or scratch paper provided by the proctor).
- Computers or calculators (except as previously noted).
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Food or drink; Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
