This is Dr. Lorie Hackett, Superintendent of Whitehall Coplay School District. I just wanted to give you a few brief updates and reminders.

We are currently past the halfway mark of the first marking period which will end November 4th.

Please remember all students should be self-screening prior to arrival at the bus stop or school. The prescreening tool can be found on our website under the COVID tab for your convenience.

Of course masks are mandatory on our school buses and in school. Students have been doing a great job wearing their masks appropriately and adhering to social distancing. All these efforts will help us remain in school and mitigate any potential spread.

Additionally, if anyone in your household is symptomatic and being tested or has been exposed to a positive case of COVID for greater than 15 minutes at less than 6 feet, all family members should remain at home until test results come back and the school nurse at the individual building should be notified. If the Department of Health has advised your household to quarantine please do not send your students to school.

Please remember that attendance whether your student is in online learning or the blended model is mandatory and students should be following the procedures outlined at their individual buildings. Students are also being graded and must complete assignments on a daily basis, again following the procedures outlined at the individual buildings and by their classroom teachers.

Finally, don't forget that next Monday, October 12th is a Professional Development day so school will be closed for students.
