FALL 2020 SPECTATOR PROCEDURES

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Whitehall-Coplay School District will implement the following spectator admission procedures in an effort to remain in compliance with the Pennsylvania Governor's current order on event gatherings. As the Governor's Order changes or if any new laws are passed, these procedures will be amended.

Girls Volleyball(Max136)

- Spectators will pre-register for tickets and those tickets will get scanned or collected to enter.
- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees event staff, and other spectators.
 - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone is in compliance.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest on our campus. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility to their vehicles.

Cross Country and Tennis

- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees event staff, and other spectators.
 - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone is in compliance.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest on our campus. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility to their vehicles.

Field Hockey & Soccer in Stadium(Max 250)

- Admission will not be charged.
- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees event staff, and other spectators.
 - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone is in compliance.
- Spectators will be permitted to sit in the side bleachers in the stadium.
 - Markings in the bleachers.
 - Household families may cluster closer than 6 feet.
- Spectators with players playing the first contest only of any JV / Varsity Doubleheader are asked to exit the facility at the conclusion of the first contest to make room for the spectators for the second contest.
 - Spectators with players playing in the second contest are asked not to arrive any earlier than 15 minutes prior to the stated game time.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest inside the stadium. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility to their vehicles.

Sub-Varsity Football (Max 951)

- Admission will not be charged.
- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees event staff, and other spectators.
 - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone is in compliance.
 - Row markings in the bleachers.
 - Household families may cluster closer than 6 feet.
- Spectators with players playing the first contest only of any Doubleheader are asked to exit the facility at the conclusion of the first contest to make room for the spectators for the second contest.
 - Spectators with players playing in the second contest are asked not to arrive any earlier than 15 minutes prior to the stated game time.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest inside the stadium. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility.

Varsity Football Games (Home)(Max 951)

- Admission will not be charged.
- Tickets will be distributed based on the number of participants, both home and away, for each particular week. Week to week ticketing may vary in quantity and process.
- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees event staff, and other spectators.
 - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone is in compliance.
 - Row markings in the bleachers.
 - Household families may cluster closer than 6 feet.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest inside the stadium. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility.
- Spectators will not be permitted outside the stadium fence to observe the contest. District Police & Security will ask you to leave.

Governor's Guidance – As of 10-6-20

Maximum Occupancy Calculator for indoor events:

Maximum Occupancy	Allowable Indoor Rate
0-2,000 people	20% of Maximum Occupancy
2,001 - 10,000 people	15% of Maximum Occupancy
Over 10,000 people	10% of Maximum Occupancy up to 3,750 people

Maximum Occupancy Calculator for outdoor events:

Maximum Occupancy	Allowable Outdoor Rate
0-2,000 people	25% of Maximum Occupancy
2,001 - 10,000 people	20% of Maximum Occupancy
Over 10,000 people	15% of Maximum Occupancy up to 7,500 people
