

Whitehall-Coplay Learn at Home Program

Getting Started (Grades K-1)

- All students in the Whitehall-Coplay School District Learn at Home program will be provided with a school-issued Chromebook. Students should login to their Chromebook using their school email address. Login information will be provided to the parent during Chromebook Distribution.
- Prior to day one, the parent will receive a video explaining the process of students accessing Seesaw via Clever and their Chromebook. **A link for Seesaw Family will be generated in the coming days or weeks to connect student journals to Seesaw Family accounts.**
- Each day, the student will check Seesaw for video conferencing links, assignments, and materials.

Recap (Steps to Get Started)

1. Login into to your Chromebook
2. Parent: Check your email for directions on how to get Chromebook and Seesaw ready for day one
3. Check Seesaw on a daily basis for new information posted by your teacher
