DESCRIPTION OF COURSE

The Reading/Language Arts Course in Grade 1 provides students with essential instruction in the areas of reading, grammar, spelling, handwriting and study skills. Harcourt Storytown Program is the core-based reading program that is utilized with this course. It is a Theme based Language Arts Program that incorporates phonics, phonological awareness, comprehension, vocabulary, fluency, and study skills with a scaffolding approach to master the necessary reading skills. Listening, speaking and writing activities are also integrated into the core reading program.
