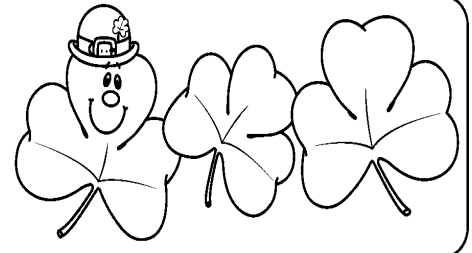

Give your child coins to practice counting money.

Help your child learn math vocabulary.

Count your stairs and steps as you walk.
